CONCEPT PAPER

Submitting a **Concept Paper** is a mandatory first step in the EngageAR grant application process. After successfully submitting and reviewing the Concept Paper, organizations will be invited to apply for AmeriCorps funding. The Concept Paper phase of the application process is designed as a "qualifying" round. Applicants with a clear method of addressing a need and the potential to develop a strong AmeriCorps program will be formally invited to apply. Final AmeriCorps applications with detailed narrative and budget will be due each **spring**.

ROLLING BASIS	Concept papers accepted and reviewed
FALL	Annual Notice of Funding Opportunity released
SPRING	Annual EngageAR AmeriCorps grant applications due. Funded programs begin no earlier than August 1.
SPRING	Application clarification period
EARLY JUNE	Funding decisions made
MID JULY	New program orientation and training
AUGUST 1	Earliest program year start







PLANNING GRANTS

Planning grants allow time and financial resources for organizations to determine and explore the feasibility of applying for an operational AmeriCorps grant. Approval of a planning grant does not guarantee an organization will be approved for an operational grant. Planning grants do not support AmeriCorps members.

OPERATIONAL GRANTS

Organizations awarded funding for an operational grant will engage AmeriCorps members to expand and/or enhance an organization's activities. EngageAR's general practice is to award no fewer than four (8) MSY with no more than 50 member slots for new grantees.
